At our last ASC meeting, the body elected Jay M as our new RCM I representative and Valerie V as our new RCM II representative and would like to thank them for their service to the fellowship.

On September 17, 2021, I was unable to attend the Virtual committee meeting. I spoke with the Chair and it was stated that the committee continues to be of great service to the El Paso Area by assisting groups on the virtual platform. The virtual committee undertook a brand new task and with courage and determination helped to keep the message going through the pandemic, my hats off to them.

September 25, 2021 I attended the activities committee meeting to begin organizing for the fall festival which will be held on October 30 at Album Park. The committee held another meeting for the event on October 2, 2021 to complete work on the flyer to be distributed to the fellowship as well as details on the menu and activities. Creating an event, putting on the event, and the clean up after it is hard selfless work and want to give thanks to the committee for all they do to keep recovery not only fun, but united.

El Paso Area-P & P Report

October 2021

Good morning, ASC Body,

P and P committee met on Wednesday, October 6, 2021 at 6pm in Zoom room #1. In attendance were Monica F., Yvonne C., Ted T., Jeff S., Christine Z. and myself. We reviewed the items on pg.10 under "Elections," and decided to combine items 7 and 8 since they were related to the same topic on how to handle elections when there are more than 2 candidates running for a position. There was also a minor change in the wording to provide better clarity. Please see Figure 2.1 for these edits.

7. If a candidate does not get the majority vote, and there are three [3] or more persons running, the two [2] with the most votes will then compete for the position. If the two [2] with the most votes do not get the majority vote, the position is held vacant until the next ASC meeting.

Next, we reviewed what was previously item 11, (now item 10) to edit the language and numeration over the procedures for officers serving consecutive terms or an extension of term. We added the phrase "Extension Clause" and the condition that an officer would have to be willing to extend their term so policy would not read as though Area could force someone to continue in their position against their will. Not that this ASC would ever do that, but we felt the need to clarify that. See Figure 2.2 for reference.

10. A second term of office can be held consecutively. However, an office cannot be held for more than two terms. A 51% majority vote by GSR/Alternate/Designated Representative is required for continuation of office. Once two terms of office have been held, a full term of the position must pass in order to be eligible for a nomination for that office again.
 - Extension Clause: In case an officer's term is over and there are no nominations, the officer's term can be extended, if the officer is willing, on a month to month basis. However, these extensions will not exceed more than three [3] months.

Finally, we made somewhat of a plan to meet and discuss points of consideration in preparation for the upcoming Area inventory, however the date for this meeting is to be determined.

I'd like to take a moment to express my gratitude to P and P Alternate, Yvonne C and everyone on the P and P committee for making each meeting a productive and efficient one. And thank you to this ASC body for allowing me to serve alongside them.



Project Vida is organizing a bilingual recovery support training and the national suicide prevention hotline number was shared.
